
collins house

two story height of the house. The main level windows and doors were replaced, but in most cases remained in the same position.




day house

- original kitchen was expanded and a family room was added. In lieu of
- attempting to match the 1930's era brick veneer, all new exterior walls were covered with stucco. Original slate was salvaged from an on-site outbuilding for new roof areas.

- More than quadrupling its size, the new addition houses a 4 car garage, the original detached "pump house"
- was used to anchor this new carriage house addition. The "pump house" was
- converted to a den.




howington house




□ mcdonnell house




□ mcdonnell house

- eas. New brackets and woodwork helps tie the new wings to the existing garage. New exterior
- brackets, doors and finishes convert the utility look of the original garage to now match the level of detail at the original house

- The new house is built on the foundations of the previous house on the property. A pond in the front yard is the focus of the front of

- This barn renovation nearly triples the size of an existing detached garage, adding new space for an extended antique car collection. The car
- barn matches the style of the existing house, appearing as more of an extension of the living
- quarters than a detached garage.

- With a series of three major remodels, this house continued to evolve from its original contemporary design to its current country
- french style. Every original room was renovated or was relocated and new rooms ap-
- proximately doubled the size of the original building.

- From the contemporary to the country french, the elevation extended main floor living space toward the
- rear yard while adding a focal point in the addition of a prominent fire-
- place and turret.

- This renovation added a second story living space above the garage. Exterior applications of a dark wood siding add a new layer of style
- to the facade of the house.

- This renovation provided an entirely new victorian appearance for an existing house which had previ-
- ously been converted to a restaurant.Highlighting extensive wood crafts-
- manship, the exterior design included wood bracketing and overhangs at the main entrance.

shankel house

- This house design underwent a complete change in appearance as new stonework and siding was applied to
- the facade. A new wing extending toward the street housing the garage and
- additional second story living space further transforms the overall shape of the house. New shutters and brackets were added to the windows and soffit to complete the transformation.

- This renovation extended a new entry roof over the front door of the residence, new garage space
- and a master bedroom suite. The original sub-grade garage space
- was converted back to basement space. Saving trees that were close to the house was an important design requirement.

theken terminal

- This project included an extensive rehabilitation effort to return the building to its original 1930's condition,
- while further renovating the interior of the historic airport terminal into a
- functioning office space. The project, which won awards at the state level for its historical preservation, kept close to the original design of the once prominent building in the Akron Fulton Airport history.

- The interior renovation underwent an extensive re-finishing. The elaborate detailing of the interior of the historic terminal was matched
- or closely replicated in the main lobby ceiling and multiple trim details were enhanced
- throughout the building. Many of the historic pieces from the original terminal building were salvaged, repaired and reinstalled, including the original clock tower and runway flood light.





toohey cottage

- The existing cottage originally built as a part-time summer cottage was demolished, leaving a very small lot with views across an existing access road to the lake
- beyond. Situated on a site with a significant elevation change from front to rear elevations, the new cottage
- cuts into the hillside, nestling an angled garage onto the tight site. A home office was incorporated into the space above the garage, with a private walkout porch off the rear of the house. The cottage-style design is an enhanced version of the original design with very efficient use of space and special attention to details such as the entry porch brackets and fireplace design.
